Must have GPA of 3.2 and no Delta Chi commitment is required. ***DELTA SIGMA THETA** - is offering scholarships to African-American students who demonstrate financial need, academic promise, and who plan to pursue an education beyond high school at an accredited institution. FERRIS STATE GREAT LAKES SCHOLARSHIP - offers eligible out of state students to pay in state tuition for up to 15 credit hours per semester. Must have class rank of top 25% and 1870 SAT or 28 ACT **OR** class rank of top 10% and 1650 SAT or 24 ACT score. Scholarship value depends on number of applicants but can range up to full tuition and

fees at IPFW for four years. Applications must be submitted by March 10, 2010. FAFSA must be completed by March 10, 2010, although financial need is not a requirement.

INDIANA SHERIFFS SCHOLARSHIP AWARD - is offered to any student committed to pursuing an education and career in law enforcement at an Indiana college or university. Applicants must be a current member of the Sheriff's Association or a dependant child or grandchild of a current member of the association. This scholarship is also available to any black or Hispanic minority student seeking a general teaching certification. Scholarship is valued at \$1000-\$4000 for minority students who demonstrate financial need and \$1000 maximum for non-minority students. NURSING SCHOLARSHIP FUND PROGRAM - offers a \$5000 scholarship to students pursuing a career in nursing in Indiana. Must demonstrate financial need, be admitted to an approved institution as a full time student, and have a
